

Since its inception, in 2003, the **McClelland Sculpture Survey & McClelland Award** has emerged as the most important biennial outdoor sculpture exhibition in Australia. This is one of the richest sculpture awards in Australia displaying a wide range of works in different media and styles by both established and emerging artists.

Sculptors nationally and internationally are eligible to enter the **McClelland Sculpture Survey**, an exhibition highlighting the diversity and invention of contemporary sculptural practice.

The 30+ sculptors will be selected to participate in the **McClelland Sculpture Survey**.

Displayed throughout 16 hectares of bush and landscaped gardens, the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** gives sculptors the opportunity to present their works in an outdoor exhibition context. The exhibition is accompanied by a major comprehensive catalogue.

Artists selected are also eligible for the **McClelland Award 2007**, an acquisitive award valued at A\$100,000. The **McClelland Award 2007** will be judged by Chris Saines, Director, Auckland Art Gallery Toi o Tāmaki, New Zealand



McClelland Sculpture Survey & Award 2007

1 McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park has established the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** and associated **McClelland Award 2007** of \$100,000 for outdoor sculpture. The Survey intends to encourage artists and support the best of contemporary sculptural practice.

2 The acquisitive **McClelland Award 2007**, will be chosen from works displayed in the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** to be exhibited in the Sculpture Park from 18 November 2007.

3 The winning sculptor will receive the **\$100,000, McClelland Award 2007**. (The recipient will have the option to take the lump sum of \$100,000 or annual payments of capital and accrued interest up to but no more than five annual payments).

4 McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park extends an open invitation to all artists to submit proposals for consideration and inclusion in the **McClelland Sculpture Survey**.

5 30+ artists will be selected to participate in the **McClelland Sculpture Survey**. Works will be displayed in the Sculpture Park from **18 November 2007 to 6 July 2008** and must be available for display for the exhibition period.

6 The opening of the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** and the announcement of the recipient of the **McClelland Award 2007** will be at the McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park on Sunday 18 November 2007.

Conditions of Entry

- 7 All entries must be the original, unique work of the artist and owned by the artist or available for acquisition.
- 8 There will be a non-refundable entry fee of A\$35. Cheques should be made payable to the McClelland Foundation Ltd.
- 9 Applications for consideration and inclusion in the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** close on **Friday 2 March 2007**.
- 10 All applications will be acknowledged.
- 11 All artists will be formally notified of the results of the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** selection by **Monday 19 March 2007**.
- 12 The judge for **The McClelland Award 2007** is Chris Saines, Director, Auckland Art Gallery Toi o Tāmaki, New Zealand
- 13 The decision of the judge is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 14 The artist must hold copyright of the work and agree to allow fair and reasonable use of images of the work for reasons of publicity/promotion and for publication.
- 15 Applicants should note that the Award is for outdoor sculpture and therefore they should be aware of the all-weather public context of the work. The works should also be archivally sound and constructed to last at least 10 years in an outdoor environment.

16 Applicants in consultation with McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park may submit a sculpture in non-archival material but the work must withstand the elements for the duration of the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** (18 November 2007 to 6 July 2008). If selected as the recipient of the McClelland Award the artist must undertake to produce the work in archivally-sound museum standard materials. Please note this proviso does not allow for the submission of maquettes and artists should be aware that judging for the McClelland Award will be made only on the final full scale works.

Entry Procedures

- 17 Applicants are requested to supply the following:
 - A current artist's CV
 - Photographs, slides or a CD of 4 recent works
 - A proposal about the work which you wish to submit
 - A photo, drawing or computer generated image of the work
 - A completed application form
 - A list of items sent
 - A stamped self-addressed A4 envelope for the return of sent items
 - All material to be clearly labelled
 - A cheque/money order/credit card details for the A\$35 entry fee made out to The McClelland Foundation Limited.
 - 18 McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park will exercise all care but assumes no responsibility for submission material.

Transportation & Installation

- 19 Artists selected to participate in the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** will receive a participation fee of \$1100 (GST Inclusive) to assist with expenses. Expenses that are the responsibility of the artist include transportation of the work to and from McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park and transit insurance of the work.
- 20 Each artist selected to participate in the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** will be invited to visit the Sculpture Park and discuss the allocation of space/sites within the grounds. If this is not possible, maps and photographs will be supplied to the artist. The final inclusion and placement of the works remains the prerogative of the McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park. The Gallery reserves the right to withdraw a work from the exhibition; any such action will be after consultation with the artist.
- 21 The Gallery, in consultation with the artist, will assist in site preparation and the installation of works. The Gallery will provide equipment, such as cranes etc, as well as an installation team to assist in the installation of the work for an agreed designated period.
- 22 Selected sculptors for the **McClelland Sculpture Survey** must have their work ready for installation from Monday 15 October 2007. Each artist will be allocated a set period for installation. Installation finishes Friday 26 October 2007.
