About the Gallery and Sculpture Park

The McClelland Gallery was established in 1971 under the terms of the Will of Annie May (Nan) McClelland in honour of her brother Harry McClelland, an artist and philanthropist who owned the property and played an instrumental role in the development of the arts community in Victoria. Harry's studio is still to be found in the grounds of the McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park, which apart from the Gallery complex, houses the community art groups of the McClelland Guild of Artists, the McClelland Spinners and Weavers, the Peninsula Woodturners Guild and the Frankston and Peninsula Lapidary Club.

The McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park

Set in 16 hectares of bush and landscaped gardens in Langwarrin, 4 kms east of Frankston on the Mornington Peninsula, the McClelland Gallery+Sculpture Park attracts thousands of visitors each year. The Gallery presents an inspiring and engaging range of changing exhibitions, public and education programs.



The unique Sculpture Park showcases over 60 sculptures by major artists such as Inge King, Lenton Parr, Clement Meadmore, Anthony Pryor, Lisa Roet and Norma Redpath.

McClelland's three indoor exhibition spaces accommodate temporary exhibitions and collection displays of works on paper, photography, painting and sculpture. The establishment of the *Elisabeth Murdoch Sculpture Foundation* at McClelland in 1989 was the catalyst for the development of a substantial sculpture collection and sculpture park. McClelland Gallery is committed to the development of sculpture in Australia.

The Collection

When the McClelland Gallery opened in 1971, its collection consisted of 138 works, with more than half of the initial contribution bequeathed from The McClelland Estate. The Gallery's collection now consists of over 1800 works of art encompassing historical, modern and contemporary paintings, and works on paper dating from the 19th Century to present day. Today the Gallery is also recognised for its important and comprehensive collection of Australian sculpture, the earliest examples dating back to the mid 1800's.
