Sanné's stunning *Black Paintings*, made from undyed unspun wool mounted on steel frames and complemented by a series of gouache paintings, derive from a series of minimal abstract canvases from the 1960s by American painter Frank Stella. These were pivotal in the way artists approached object and surface, and embody many of the contradictory impulses within late modern and contemporary art practice. By reviving and re-posing Stella's paintings, Mestrom draws attention to the way meaning and value are created, suspended or turned inside out, while redressing imbalances in art history.
